

City of Weston

Last spring the City of Weston started providing accessible AED (Automatic External Defibrillators) machines in our three main parks. Up to now we have kept these in meeting rooms or concession buildings that at times were locked up. Not very useful in the event of an emergency. We have changed that with exterior mounting cabinets like the one pictured:

These should be standing out by now but I wanted to highlight their installation and location (see attached maps) so that you can become familiar with them. They are currently installed as follows (near drinking fountains):

REGIONAL PARK:

- B1 Restroom near Soccer Field 3.
- A2 Restroom near Baseball 5-8.

TEQUESTA TRACE PARK:

- Playground restroom building.
- Football restroom building.
- Baseball restroom building.

VISTA PARK:

- Softball restroom building.
- Soccer restroom building.

AED machines are a bit intimidating but not that difficult to use. There is an automated voice that walks you through the directions in the event of an emergency.
